The **ECOLUTION MSc** consortium met in Prague, Czech Republic, for its first in-person project meeting to finalize plans and prepare for the new semester.

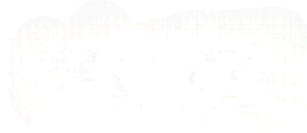
